



How to Type Foreign Characters

This is a list of foreign characters enterable in just about any Windows word processor, text editor, browser or email client. To get these characters:

1. Make sure your keyboard is in NumLock mode.
2. Hold down the ALT key and enter the number on the numeric keypad, releasing ALT only after you have finished typing the numbers. (Note that many laptops have a blue FN key that changes a set of keys, also with blue numbers on them and usually in the 7-8-9-U-I-O area, into a numeric keypad.)
3. Consult this handy chart:
