Dear Sir

I much regret that I have been unable to complete your casts according to the written list, also that I have been so increasingly occupied with Museum work & have found myself unable up till now to write & say that I have an equal number of casts prepared which I can send if you are still open to receive them

I found that my moulds of some 3 or 4 (not by any means the more interesting ones) had perished & I have replaced them by different casts, not having been able to re model from the originals, by reason of a new order for bidding

the moulding of all terra-
cotta & soft stone objects
in the Museum.

Will you allow me to
send this equal number
as agreed for together
with the original bricks
my father sold to you
when in London, & also would
you send any further instructions
as to the sending that
the lapse of time may have
made necessary —
