Dear Prof Lyon:

As we have the larger portion of the Wood Collection prepared and about ready for sending off, we are writing to ask you if you do not think we had better finish up and ship to you the specimens now ready. There are about one hundred in all, and they will fill one or two large cases. Of the rest of the collection only a few are yet to be secured, nearly all having been got together and are now in process of curing.

In view of making a shipment to you we would like to advise with you as to how the specimens should be finished. As to the hard woods which are susceptible of a polish we propose to leave one half of one surface on one side plain and to have the other half polished. All cross sections we thought to leave plain, only cleaned up and sand-papered. We propose that they should each one bear two marks, one to indicate the cutting and the other to correspond, as to the order in which they come, with the botanical order of the specimens. We would also send a label for each one, a sample of which label we are enclosing.

We would like to hear from you on these points, ie the style of finish, the label, as to whether it is just as you wish it, and as to our sending off soon a shipment containing the specimens that are

prepared.

Since you were here we have been successful in collecting fine specimens of pottery, especially Canaanitish and Israelitish. We have duplicates of quite a number of the best specimens, and so, if you wished them we could supply you with some very desireable ones at a reasonable figure. If you feel at all interested in this please let us know and we will write you more fully as to what we could supply.

Some of our brothers have just visited the Samaria excavations, and found great and interesting progress being made. Dr. Reisner was just beginning a trench across a section of the colonnade just below where the main excavations on the summit are being made, and this exploration is to continue up the hill side to where they are now working.
